In order for us to establish your file and save time once you are in our office, the doctor has asked that you complete the following diagnostic forms and bring them with you to your appointment.

- Completed Welcome to the Office form:** This information will aid us in establishing your file as well as your current eye health and vision status.
- Completed Medical and Eye Health History:** Since many general health conditions may be associated with visual symptoms and/or eye health problems this diagnostic information will assist the doctor in caring for you as a “whole person” rather than just a pair of eyes.

***Important:** This form includes asking for a **complete list of prescription and non-prescription medications** that you are currently taking. If you prefer, you may bring it in as a separate list for us to photocopy.*

- Signed Acknowledgement of Receipt and General Consent:** This is the consent for the release of health information for purposes of treatment and payment
- Completed Lifestyle Questionnaire:** This information will help us to properly prescribe the best materials for your lifestyle.
- Share the Care:** Refer a new patient to us and we’ll credit your account \$10 toward your next optical purchase.
- Please bring the following with you to your exam:**
 - Insurance card or claim forms
 - Eyeglasses: please bring ALL pairs of eyeglasses you are currently using
 - Contact Lenses: If possible, it is best to wear your current contact lenses to your appointment. It would be helpful if you bring along your cartons or lens packets that indicate lens series, power and manufacturer
 - Eye drops, ointments, etc: Please bring any eye drops and ointments that you are currently using so the doctor can review them to see if they are the best option for you.

Dilation Explanation: The doctor may need to use drops to dilate your eyes in order to fully evaluate your eye health. This has the effect of temporarily increasing sensitivity to light and causing “fuzzy” vision at a near (reading) distance. If you want to select new eyewear, please come in 15 to 20 minutes before your appointment time in order to look at our frame selection.
